Following the EGM held on Saturday 27th September 2003, the Severn Valley Railway Wolverhampton Branch was given a mandate to revitalise interest in 7819 Hinton Manor. After negotiations with the SVR Rolling Stock Trust, it was decided that in the best interests of keeping (and running) the loco on the Severn Valley Railway, the Trust becomes the new custodians of the loco.

The official hand-over was on Saturday 17th of April 2004 at Kidderminster Town station.
