Blackpool Tram Trip – Wednesday 17th June 2009

Wolverhampton branch has arranged a further trip to Blackpool for a day on their tramway system, incorporating hire of a “Coronation” Vambac car, and a guided tour of Rigby Road depot, at the cost of an additional donation to their own charity.

The itinerary involves meeting at Rigby Road at 10:00 a.m. for the tour of the depot. The tram then leaves at 11:00 a.m. for Starr Gate, followed by Sandcastle and Pleasure Beach. After a 45 minute break it will return to Rigby Road.

The tram would then proceed to Fleetwood, incorporating as many loops and crossovers as possible. This would include, in particular Bispham Loop has been requested, as has a trip to the P.way yard at Thornton Cleveleys (if possible). After a break of 1 hour (chip stop!!) the tram will return to Fishermans Walk Crossover for a photographic run past.

A return would then be made to Rigby Road.

The cost of the trip will be £16.50 per person.

It is not possible for us to arrange transport for the journey. However, we have checked that there is a train which leaves Wolverhampton Station at approximately 7:30 a.m., arriving in Blackpool at approx 9:30 a.m. (change at Preston). For those not wishing to visit the depot there is a train one hour later. Car sharing may be arranged.
